#### Summary

I am a registered Clinical Psychologist with 13 years of experience working with babies, children, adults and families across diverse clinical settings in the UK and internationally. I specialized in perinatal mental health and parent-infant assessments and therapeutic work and currently work as a Principal Psychologist in a Perinatal Community Mental Health Team. I have also a specialist interest in working with young children in their early years and adults with complex emotional needs.

I have previously worked in CAMHS, supporting children and adolescents with emotional and behavioural difficulties, including looked-after children and those on the edge of care. I have also worked with a Local Authority, providing specialist assessments and therapy for adults with complex mental health needs.
